In reference to Circular No. (381000091275) dated 05/25/2017 AD regarding the regulatory guide for information security in the financial sector, in reference to Circular No. (246) dated 04/24/2024 AD regarding the principles of cyber threat analysis, and in reference to Circular No. (249) dated 18/ 05/2022 AD regarding the Regulatory Guide for Business Continuity Management, and in reference to Circular No. (250) dated 05/26/2022 AD regarding the Regulatory Guide for Information Security and in reference to Circular No. (45015218) dated 09/19/2023 AD regarding confirmation of compliance with the updated personal data protection law and its executive regulations, and in reference to Insurance Authority Circular No. (272) dated 11/23/2023 AD regarding the Authority's electronic addresses and to ensure the continuity of effective supervision and control of cyber risks in the insurance sector.

We would like to emphasize the continuation of implementation of the instructions and rules related to cyber risks issued previously, and we would like to inform you of the establishment of electronic addresses for the specializations of cyber risk requests, as follows:

#	Jurisdiction/requests	E-mail
1	All topics and requirements related to cyber risk control	CRC.Compliance@IA.GOV.SA
2	To send and receive cyber incident notifications or cyber security warnings	CRC-IMT@IAGOVS.A

Accordingly, companies must update the contact information related to monitoring cyber risks and create an e-mail - not linked to a specific employee - dedicated to responding to notifications of incidents and cybersecurity warnings and provide the Authority with this data according to what is contained in the table attached via e-mail: CRC.Compliance@IA.GOV.SA This shall be within five working days from the date of this circular
